
Roger Hawkins, Jimmy Turner, Joe Smith, Brandon Stagnolia, Dylan Baker and DeWayne White were all present.


Jimmy made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Dylan. Motion passed at 7:14 pm by a vote of 5 – 0.
