



ORDINANCE 2020-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART OF SECTION 50.11 OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN,
INDIANA CODE OF ORDINANCES REGULATING BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Austin desires to amend Section 50.11 of the Code of Ordinances which regulates bulky item trash collection in the City of Austin; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council desires to adopt a more efficient and user-friendly process for bulky item pickup.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN that Section 50.11 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and recodified as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 50.11 shall now read:

- A. For the removal of bulky items that will not fit into a trash bag, the city resident shall contact the Clerk-Treasurer's office to request the removal of the bulky item. Any bulky items shall not be placed adjacent to the curb immediately adjacent to the individual's residence or within three feet of the curb or traveled portion of the street prior to said removal request being made to the Clerk-Treasurer for the collection service.
- B. Bulky items, including all large household items such as furniture, mattresses, grills, stoves, water heaters, and other appliances, will be acceptable for this collection. Refrigerators, air conditioners, or other items which normally contain CFCs (Freon), will not be collected unless documentation is provided that the CFCs have been properly removed. No hazardous materials, lead acid batteries, tires, or any other items prohibited by federal, state, county, or local laws or regulations will be accepted.
- C. The charge for pickup of any bulky item or appliance is Ten Dollars (\$10) per item. All charges will be billed by the city along with the bill for sewage services and shall be payable at the same time as the sewage bills.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall have no effect upon any other provisions of Section 50.11 except as herein provided, and all other sections of said Section not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.
