Roger Hawkins, Jimmy Turner, DeWayne White, Dylan Baker, Brandon Stagnolia and Joe Smith were all present.


Minutes: Brandon made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 8th and June 23rd meetings, seconded by Dylan. Motion passed 5 – 0.

Joe made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021 – 10 on the first reading, seconded by DeWayne. Motion passed 5 – 0. Chris Fugate, clerk treasurer, then read Resolution 2021 – R – 10, Authorizing and Approving the Entry into an Inter - local Agreement for the Investment of Public Funds. Dylan Made a motion to approve Resolution 2021 – R – 10, seconded by DeWayne. Motion passed 5 – 0. Josh then read Resolution 2021 – R – 11, Establishing a Residential TIF District. Brandon made a motion to approve Resolution 2021 – R – 11, seconded by Jimmy. Motion passed 5 – 0. Donald Spicer asked the council to officially recognize Spicertown, and would like to place a sign to welcome people to the area. Donald stated that he would work on raising the funds for the signage. Josh stated that he would have a resolution at the August meeting. 
Adjournment: Jimmy made a motion to adjourn a 7:27pm, seconded by Brandon. Motion passed 5 – 0.


