Minutes: Jimmy made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 11th, meeting seconded by Joe. Motion passed 3 – 0.





New Business: Jimmy asked Robert about 120 N. 1st Street. Robert stated that he had issued citations to the property owner.


Adjournment: Jimmy made a motion to adjourn at 5:34 pm, seconded by Joe. Motion passed 3 – 0.




