ORDINANCE 2019-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART OF SECTION 34.03 OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, INDIANA CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING LONGEVITY PAY

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Austin desires to amend Section 34.03 of the Code of Ordinances which concerns longevity pay of employees of the City of Austin.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN that Section 34.03 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and recodified as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 34.03 (H) shall now read:

- (H) Employee Longevity Pay:
 - (1) Longevity pay for eligible employees of the City of Austin, except police officers of the City, shall be paid at the rate of \$100 for each year of continuous full-time service up to ten (10) years of service. Longevity pay shall not exceed \$1,000 per employee.
 - (2) Longevity pay is to be paid to permanent police officers at one percent (1%) of a First-Class Patrol Officer's salary upon completion of one full year of service with one percent additional for each full year thereafter, not to exceed ten percent (10%) of a First-Class Patrol Officer's salary. Longevity pay, per permanent police officer, shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of a First-Class Patrol Officer's salary.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall have no effect upon any other provisions of Section 34.03 except as herein provided, and all other sections of said Section not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the other remaining parts.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
